OPEN ENTRY

Single, round sponge

This division is for an "orthodox" sponge
(no packet mixes)
8" / 20 cm round NB NO icing

Judging criteria:
Volume, general appearance and texture

OPEN ENTRY

Scones

A plate of four scones with an
approximate width of 5 cm each

Judging criteria:
Volume and general appearance, internal
appearance and taste

CHILD UP TO 8 YEARS

Cupcake Decoration

A plate of 4 decorated cupcakes
Children in this age group are NOT required to
cook their own cupcakes, ONLY to decorate them

Judging criteria:
General appearance and originality

JUNIOR AGE 9-14 YEARS

Decorated Cupcakes

A plate of four decorated cupcakes. Juniors are
to both cook and decorate their cupcakes

Judging criteria:
General appearance, technical difficulty
and originality

HURRY - Entries close Tuesday 9 March 2010

Entry conditions

- The competition is for amateur bakers and decorators only.
- All entries must include a Routley's Bakery Challenge entry form attached to their submitted sponge/cakes/scones.
- Entries should be dropped off at Routley's Bakery, 56 Douglas Parade, Williamstown between 16.00 and 18.00 on Tuesday 9 March 2010.
- Individuals may enter each division only once and a separate entry form is required for each entry.
- Entry is free.
- Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Judging will take place on the evening of 9 March 2010 at Routley's Bakery.
- A list of winners will be posted in the window of Routley's Bakery on Wednesday 10 March, 2010.
- Prize ribbons will be awarded after the opening ceremony of the Williamstown Festival at 13.00 on Saturday 13 March at the Rotunda, Commonwealth Reserve, Williamstown.
- Winners agree to the publication of their names and any photographs of the award presentation.
